Students in this Advanced Ayurvedic Bodywork class will gain knowledge and experience in the preparation and uses of herbs in spa and detoxification treatments, as well as proficiency in administering these treatments.

Ayurvedic Hydrotherapy treatments will be emphasized, including making and administering therapeutic herbal plasters for pain and detoxification, castor oil packs, and detoxifying tea wraps. Students will also spend time practicing and continuing to gain proficiency in treatments learned in their first introduction class, including Ubyartan Aromatic Herbal exfoliations, and Shirodhara.
